1597	William Chase-(1597) believed to have been born this date.		
1603	Mary-(1603) (wife of Wm.-1597) born in Chesham, Norfolk, England.		
1620	The Mayflower Pilgrims who arrived in 1620 were Separatists. They wanted to separate from the Church of England. The Pilgrims were not Quakers.		
1621	William Chase-(1621), born this date, son of Wm. Chase-(1597) and Mary-(1603)	(S2) Wm. Chase-(1621) was married but no record of her name due to fire that destroyed records.	William-(1621) died in 1684-5 at Harwich, Cape Cod.
1627	William Chase-(1597) married Mary this date according to (S3).		He would have been 30 when he married Mary-(1603).
1630	This is the date the Puritans began to arrive. They wanted to Purify the Church of England. They were a group of English Protestants who in the 16th - 17th centuries, after the Reformation, sought further simplification of the ceremonies and creeds of the Church of England and strict religious discipline.		
1630	(S2) William Chase (1597) came with the first company to America. This was the fleet that brought Winthrop to Salem in 1630. Wm. believed to have been born about 1584 according to (S2) but according to (S3), he was born in Nov, 1597 in Wivenhoe, Essex, England. Legend has it (as set forth in (S2) he came from Lincolnshire, but Theodore R. Chase of Detroit and Eardley Thomas think he was from Yarmouth, England.	(S2) He was the first person with that name to come here. (S2) He came with one child, his ill son, William-(1621). (S2) His wife's name was, Mary-(1603) who was ill. According to Erdley-Thomas), "Her malady and recovery are described in" a letter by Dr. Oliver Wendell Holmes. (S2) Took the freeman's oath. Was at first a staunch Puritan but converted to being a Quaker for details described on page 2 of (S2).	Distinguish between Pilgrims, Puritans, and Quakers. The Puritans actually persecuted the Quakers and believed they were heretics.
1637	(S2) William Chase-(1597) had a daughter in March 1637, with the ill wife after she recovered and they named her, Mary-(1637).	(2) The family moved with a new Company to a new planation in Yarmouth. (date not mentioned). This daughter, Mary suffered from a paralysis interestingly described in (S2) and based upon the records of 1 st Church of Roybury, MA - Rev. Joshua Eliot Weston (sp?)	
1645	(S2) First child also named William was born to Wm. Chase-(1621)	(S2) Names of his children were Jacob (b. 1647), Joseph, Samuel, John, Elizabeth. There may also have been a William; not clear from this geneology.	(S2)All his children except John and Elizabeth are found in Rhode Island from 1680 two 1701. About 1700 William, Jacob, Joseph and Samuel went to Swansea.
1647	(S2) Jacob Chase born		He later married Mary.

1659	(S2) Wm Chase-(1597) died in May, 1659 . Chase's wife was also found dead this year presumably of natural causes based on a coroner's report. *		* See our Mary (1630) file.
1682	William Penn and the Quakers began arriving in 1682 aboard the Welcome. A member of the Religious Order of Friends founded by George Fox , Quaker derives from `To tremble at the word of the Lord ` -To Quake ` The Quakers settled in Pennsylvania while the Puritans settled in Massachusetts .		
1684	William Chase-(1621) died in Harwich, Cape Cod.
